Mark your calendar with the remaining 2024 market dates: 3 August, 7 September, 5 October, 2 November and 7 December.



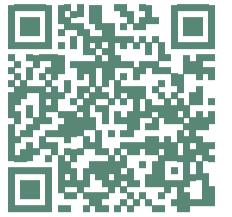
HAVE YOUR SAY: DISABILITY ACTION PLAN STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK

Council invites Golden Plains Shire community members to provide feedback on the Draft Disability Action Plan Strategic Framework 2025-2029 (the Draft Plan).

The Draft Plan has been developed to create a framework that supports people with disabilities and other access challenges, enabling them to engage with Council and access all the organisation's services.

The Draft Plan's objective is to enable clearly identifiable actions in the Council Plan that aim to improve the overall quality of life for people living, working and visiting the Shire. SHELFORD PLAY SPACE CONCEPT DESIGN OPEN FOR FEEDBACK

Golden Plains Shire Council has developed a concept design for upgrading the existing Play Space at Shelford Recreation Reserve, with community members invited to share their thoughts on the proposed design.

The concept design includes new play equipment such as an in-ground trampoline, standing spinner with rubber surround, climbing logs, giant basket swing, double playground swing, large treehouse playground tower, bush cubby, and scramble logs and boulders.

Additional features of the design include street furniture, pathways, a gravel carpark with markings and accessible parking bays, an accessible picnic setting, and a 3-metre-high ball barrier fence to the oval side of the Play Space.
