INTRODUCTION:

The Northern Streetscapes Framework Project (the Project), introduced in 2021 aims to enhance the main streetscapes of Smythesdale, Scarsdale, and Linton. Focused on beautification upgrades, the Project seeks to improve the character of these towns along the Glenelg Highway, benefiting both residents and visitors.

Planned enhancements include minor streetscape upgrades and placemaking improvements, such as enhancing accessibility and connectivity, reviewing pavement treatments, modifying parking arrangements, planning vegetation succession, and improving road and pedestrian safety. Potential additions include more accessible street crossings, re-evaluating garden beds and street trees, and improving street furniture like seating, bin covers, and bike racks.

The Project adheres to Rural Roads Victoria's safety standards, ensuring that while beautification is a priority, there won't be major road alignment changes, intersection upgrades or undergrounding power.

Council initially sought feedback from the community in May 2021, which informed the designs for the Project. The Northern Streetscapes Framework Project was officially adopted by Council in April 2022.

We are now seeking further community engagement to ensure the current framework reflects the needs and aspirations of the community. Residents of Smythesdale, Scarsdale, and Linton can share their thoughts through an online survey or by participating in listening posts. Your feedback will guide any necessary adjustments to the Northern Streetscapes Project Concept Designs.

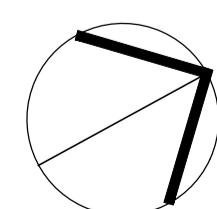

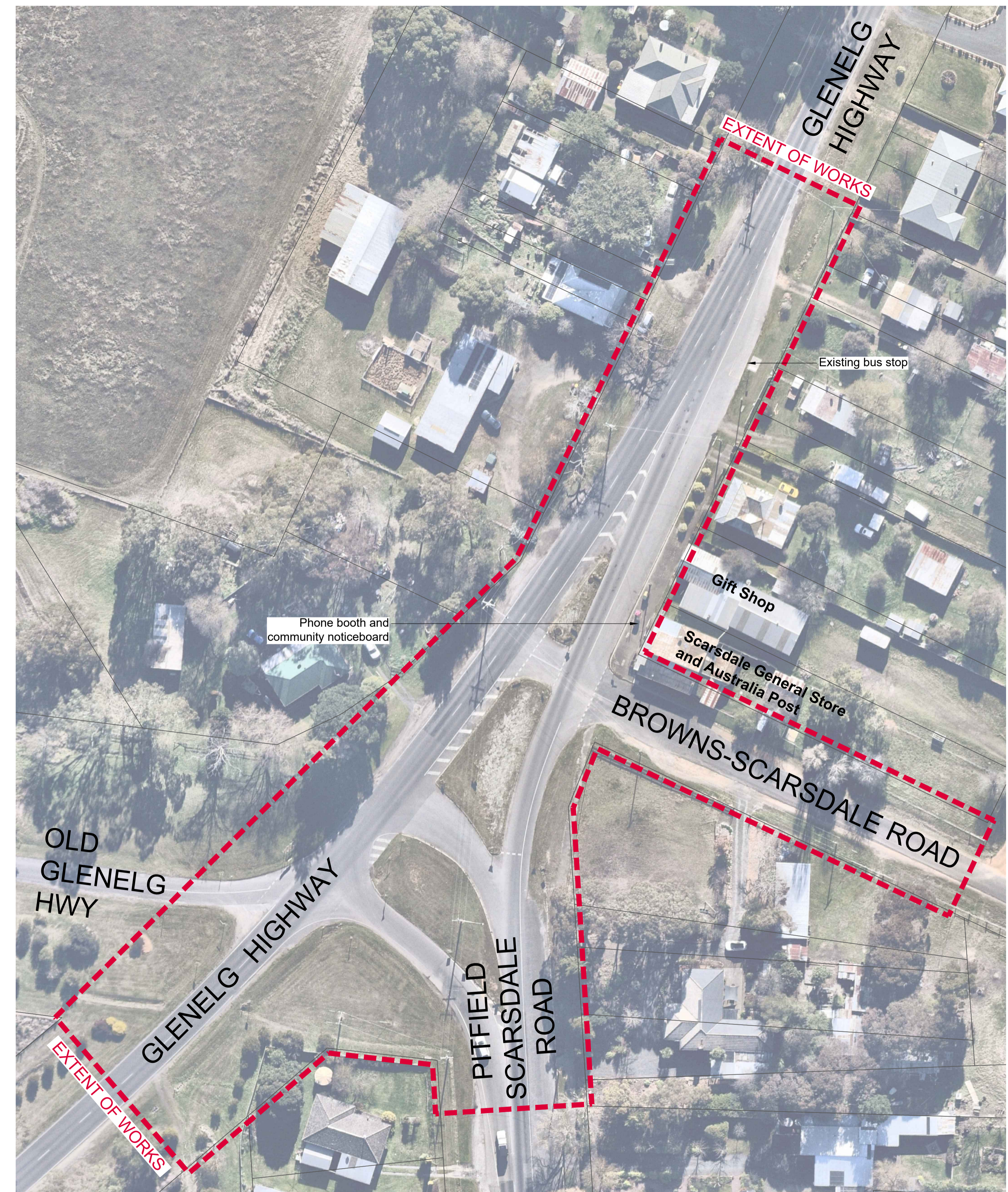

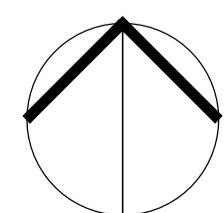

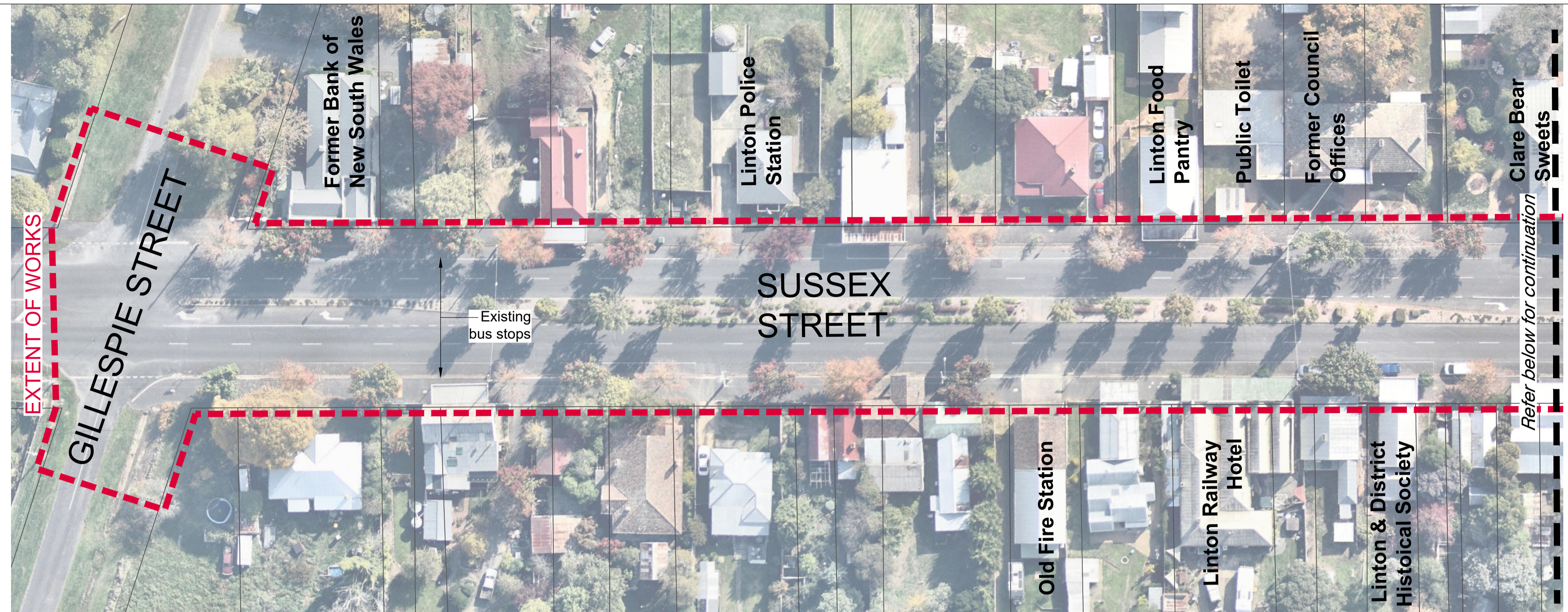

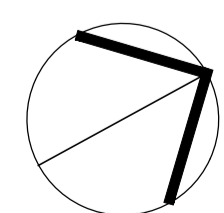
