



LINTON STREETSCAPE

KEY RECOMMENDATIONS

Thank you for your response to the community consultation for the streetscape upgrade works identified for Linton in September 2024. Our design team have listened to your input and developed a draft concept plan for your review. Please share your thoughts in relation to the plans.

STREET TREES & SOFT LANDSCAPING

- A. Large canopy trees are proposed within tree bays / pits to increase canopy cover over the road and car park area. Ensure tree species and location meets Department of Transport and Planning and Powercor guidelines (overhead powerlines).
- B. Existing Pear trees to be assessed by an Arborist and replaced as required over a 10 year time frame. Remove asphalt paving and replace with garden bed or grass to increase soil volume for tree roots.
- C. Replace low quality overgrown planting around the Pioneer Memorial to improve visibility and amenity.
- D. Remove Robinia's to prevent damage to historic building verandas. Consider replacing with ornamental Grape Vines.
- E. Replace / infill planting in Sussex Street median strip. Use hardy low growing shrubs, groundcovers, bladed plants and grasses to reduce ongoing maintenance and watering requirements.

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS & SAFETY

- F. Provide an accessible pedestrian crossing between former CFA and Police station with kerb outstand, pram crossings and signage.
- G. Footpath repairs along Sussex Street including localised repairs to cracked / raised asphalt in the short term. Street trees to be reviewed by council Arborist. Trees that are creating trip hazard may need to be removed, subject to Arboricultural advice.

STREET FURNITURE

H. Street furniture including new furniture and refurbishment (bike racks and seats).

SIGNAGE

I. Provide wayfinding signage from the Rail Trail to Edinburgh Reserve.

NOTES

- Re-do line marking to northbound car parks on north of Clyde Street.
- Car parking numbers to be confirmed.
- Plant species selection to highlight township theme / character. Each township to have distinctive / different planting to reinforce identity.
- Plant selection subject to finalisation and availability.








PROPOSED SECTION E-E
